#### HRMA ANNUAL REPORT 2019-2020

HRMA Executive Committee in 2019 formed multiple subcommittees and had various detailed discussions focused on giving back to the community.

**HRMA Newsletter:** In the interest of being connected with community. HRMA committee decided to publish newsletter thrice a year (September, January and May). HRMA wanted to recognize community contributions/achievements, awards, professional advancements and significant life events of Malayalee's in the Hampton roads area. Primary focus was to inspire and motivate the school aged children in the academics as well as in any area of talent by the citations in the newsletter.

**HRMA website:** HRMA website is annually updated with our financial audit report, current governing body and is accessible for all our members and nonmembers. For new Malayalee's, we have facilities in our website for subscriptions and requesting memberships online. Also we publish the details of sponsors in the HRMA website.

**HRMA Malayalam Classes:** HRMA conducts Malayalam classes teaching youth the basics of the language at Bayside Presbyterian Church, Virginia Beach. This year the subcommittee Biju and Ajish along with help of six volunteers Linda, Bini, Snitha, Nisaraj, Rejith and Anjaly worked on improvising the curriculum to more structured way introducing learning aids like stories, poems read/write sessions, charts and projectors. Also increased the frequency of classes from once to twice a month. Our goal is to provide language tools for the children and help them develop their own sense of understanding of the language. The cost associated with holding classes will be solely covered by donations.
