HRMA's contribution to fight against COVID-19

During the first quarter, we joined hands with Hague Pharmacy to obtain Covid Vaccine for our community members falling under Phase 1A and 1B categories. We also devised a year-long roadmapfor 2021 and established multiple subcommittees to oversee and execute our plannedprograms. We also created a COVID-19 Fundraising Campaign to aid India in its fight against the crisis. HRMA as a community raised \$1600, which is equal to Rs106,750 (One Lakh Six Thousand Seven Hundred and Fifty rupees), and contributed to Kerala's Chief Minister Distress Relief Fund (CMDRF) to aid India's fight against the COVID-19 disaster. The funds generated through this campaign were all donated to the Kerala Chief Ministers' Disaster Relief Fund.

Clean the Bay Day

On June 5th 2021, HRMA in association with Chesapeake Bay Foundation volunteered for the "Clean the Bay Day" to help clean, protect, and make our shorelines even more beautiful by picking up litter. By participating in Clean the Bay Day 2021, our mission was to we pledge to get outside, pick up litter, and work to improve the wellbeing of the 18 million people and 3,000 species of plants and animals that call the Virginia watershed home. The event was organized at Sandbridge Beach and marked an attendance of 38 volunteers. The event witnessed active participation of HRMA Youth Club members to make a positive change in our community. We are truly proud of the steps we took together towards clean water, clean air, and sustainable resources for all. 
